

PRIVACY POLICY

1. This Privacy Policy sets out the principles for the processing and protection of personal data provided by Users in connection with their use of travel Websites through the Website.
2. The Administrator of the personal data contained in the Website is Anita Michalska-Saczek, resident at 118 Kołaczkowice, 42-120 Miedźno (hereinafter referred to as the Owner).
3. The Administrator processes personal data on the basis of consent given by the User and in cases where the provisions of law authorize the Administrator to process personal data under the provisions of law or in order to implement an agreement concluded between the parties.
4. The Website performs functions of obtaining information on users and their behavior in the following manner:
 - a. through information voluntarily entered in forms
 - b. through the collection of "cookies" [see cookie policy].
5. The Website collects information voluntarily provided by the user.
6. The data provided in the form are processed in order to conclude an agreement, make settlements, provide service and using any consumer rights by the User (e.g. withdrawal from the agreement, warranty).
7. Personal data left in the Website will not be sold or made available to third parties, in accordance with the provisions of the Act on Personal Data Protection.
8. The data contained in the form can be viewed by the individual who posted it. This person also has the right to modify and stop processing their data at any time.
9. We reserve the right to change the privacy policy of the Website, which may be affected by the development of Internet technology, possible changes in the law on the protection of personal data and the development of our website. We will inform about any changes in a visible and understandable way.
10. The Website may contain links to other websites. Such websites operate independently of the Website and are in no way supervised by willaskalinada.pl. These websites may have their own privacy policies and regulations, with which we recommend that you become familiar.

COOKIES POLICY

1. Website does not collect any information automatically, except for information contained in cookies.
2. Cookies are computer data, in particular text files that are stored in the device of the Website User and are designed to use the Website. Cookies usually contain the name of the website from which they come, the time of storing them on the terminal equipment and a unique number.
3. Entity placing cookies on the terminal equipment of the Website User and accessing them is the Service operator.
4. Cookies are used in order to:
 - a. adjusting the content of the Website to the User's preferences and optimizing the use of websites; in particular, these files enable recognition of the Website User's device and appropriate display of the website, adjusted to his individual needs;
 - b. creation of statistics, which help to understand how the Website User uses websites, which enables improvement of their structure and content;
 - c. maintaining a session of the Website User (after logging), thanks to which a User does not have to re-enter login and password on each subpage of the Service;

- d. adjustment of advertising content in graphic form (display advertisements) with the use of Google Analytics remarketing
5. There are two main types of cookies used on the Website: "session" (session cookies) and "persistent" cookies (persistent cookies). „Session" cookies are temporary files that are stored in the User's terminal equipment until logging out, leaving the website or switching off the software (web browser). "Permanent" cookies are stored in the terminal equipment of User for the time specified in the parameters of cookies or until they are removed by the User.
6. The following types of cookies are used within the Website:
 - a. "indispensable" cookies enabling use of services available within the Website, e.g. authentication cookies used for services requiring authentication within the Website;
 - b. cookies used to ensure safety, e.g. used for detecting abuses in the scope of authentication within the Service;
 - c. "efficiency" cookies, enabling gathering information about the manner of use of the Website websites;
 - d. "functional" cookies, enabling "remembering" the settings selected by a User and personalizing User interface, e.g. in the scope of selected language or region from which a User comes from, font size, website layout etc;
 - e. "advertising" cookies that make it possible to provide Users with advertising content more suited to their interests.
7. In many cases, software used to browse the Internet (web browser) by default allows storage of cookies in the User's end device. Users of the Website may at any time change their settings concerning cookies. These settings can be changed in particular in such a way as to block the automatic handling of cookies in the settings of your web browser or inform on their timely placement in the equipment of User of the Service. Detailed information on the possibility and methods of using cookies is available in software settings (web browser). Users can block the Analytics service for display ads and customize ads in the Google Ads Network in the Ads Preferences Manager. You can also download the Google Analytics blocking program from <https://tools.google.com/dlpage/gaoptout/>.
8. The Operator of the Website informs that restrictions on the use of cookies may affect some of the functionality available on the Website.
9. Cookies placed in the Website User's device, can be also used by advertisers and partners cooperating with the Service Operator.
